



ItrezzoAgent Server Release Notes

12 November 2007 - Version 3.4.00

Agent

- Fixed interaction with the watchdog service that can cause it to terminate a running EPS task prematurely.
- Added logic to record the date when each handheld requests the PIN DL xml after receiving a push notification.
- Modified task description displayed by EPS in the admin Servers container when retrieving data from alternate sources.
- Disabled automatic enrollment of new users in "Eval" license pack.
- Corrected issue that occasionally generates stub log file with missing host name.

Admin

- An alert now gets raised if the user attempts to launch EPS, BPE, BPE or SSU on demand but the requested action will not run because the server is actively running a different task.
- Added column to display the date and time when a handheld last fetched its PIN blast packet. The fetch is the second and final part of the PIN DL transaction, initiated when a notification gets pushed to the handheld that a new or updated PIN DL is available.
- The Last Push date now gets updated immediately (without requiring a view refresh) if a push notification for a PINDL gets sent directly from the admin.

31 October 2007 - Version 3.3.18

Agent

- Added ability to separately configure which update actions the agent performs (write/overwrite/clear) on each data field for each class of contact (mandatory and standard).
- Added logic to skip removal of obsolete contacts if any mandatory contact list is found with no targets and/or no sources. The protection logic is implemented whether EPS collects the data at the start of the run or uses the cached reference set. Any MCL that actually has no specified sources and/or targets should be inactivated if you want to use the Remove Obsolete Contacts option.
- Fixed bug that could cause parsing of MCL source or target lists to fail.
- Fixed bug in logic that eliminates duplicate emails on Mandatory Contacts.
- The EPS summary now reports separate totals for added, updated and removed Mandatory Contacts. The attached CSV now also includes columns for Mandatory Notes that were added, updated or removed.
- Fixed bug that could release MAPI session while BPE task was in process, generating excessive duplicate entries in Handhelds folder.
- Improved task threading management, which makes the service behave better if it receives a shutdown or restart command while any task is running.
- Updates to the File As field are now more consistent with Outlook rules. In some cases the previous logic could trigger repeated backups and alternating changes to this field on some contacts. That churn is fixed, and also a change that only affects the format is no longer reported to the user.
- The contact Subject is now updated to match if the Display Name is changed.
- A change was made to the way that email fields are updated to support Entourage. One of the email display fields now shows the SMTP address instead of the user name.
- The Exchange Home Server field is no longer cleared when EPS fails to log on to a user mailbox. Some additional test procedures are also now run for any logon failure. These changes are for diagnostic purposes.

- Corrected a bug that would set the flag to only update mandatory contacts in a user subfolder if a user override matched the global setting to “use subfolder”.
- Improved logic that tests for failed updates to user contacts, which reduces the number of false positives in Exceptions log.
- Fixed bug that could cause evaluation of private fields to fail when using cached reference data.
- The agent now maintains an internal record of updates to the service DLL.
- Fixed bug that could allow the BPE task to launch while EPS is still running, which can cause BPE to generate duplicate handheld registrations if EPS finishes and releases the shared MAPI session while BPE is still running.
- Improved flexibility of task scheduling logic to better handle condition where two tasks have the same or nearly identical launch times. The second task is now kept pending for up to five minutes to allow the first task to complete before forcing a reschedule.
- Fixed bug that could cause the agent to delete license packs and other internal data if communication with Exchange gets disrupted repeatedly.
- Removed size limitations that prevented EPS from adding display names and email addresses to its dataset that exceed arbitrary character lengths.
- Fixed bug that sometimes assigned invalid X500 addresses when WriteODN flag is enabled.
- Added logic to monitor task progress, improving service reliability.
- Exception log entries now include the date in the timestamp, and a bug in tallying the exception count was fixed.
- Fixed bugs in launching of BPP task that could shift scheduled time by 1 hour, or could cause task to be skipped by incorrectly calculating a collision with another task.
- EPS now includes ‘+’ character in addition to digits when doing a comparison on a phone field to see if it should be updated.

Admin

- Fixed address selection dialog so that it doesn't drop existing addresses if you use Cancel to close the dialog.
- Added UI to enable and configure EPS data field control.
- Added context menu option in SSU container to open the edit URL for the selected user.
- Fixed bug in option to restart the service on a server with a running task that sometimes only stopped the service without completing a restart.
- Fixed bug in server properties dialog where checkbox for enabling BPE was not in synch with enabled state for that task.
- Eliminated all references to ESN field in handheld registrations; Find dialog now uses PIN for lookups.
- Eliminated display of Domain Lookup and Personality Agent containers.
- On demand push now tries to use SMTP address as destination if push fails using PIN.
- The email display name value is now used wherever contact details are displayed, instead of the literal email value (so an actual X500 ODN-type address will now appear as an SMTP address the way it does on the handheld, in Outlook or in OWA.)
- View of PINDL list now always uses the value from Handhelds folder if it's available, which is how the server has always worked. Previously that view would preferentially use the PIN value from the Master Contact Repository if it existed, which might be out of date.
- Fixed bug in Folder Picker dialog which would lock the application in a loop if the target data store could not be opened.
- Added caching to AD selection form to improve loading after first use.
- Added menu option to view SSU edit page for a selected user.
- Fixed bug that lost location of splitter bar during restore of form.

- Added enumeration of MCLs to startup diagnostics.
- Agent now sends alert at startup about any active public and mailbox folder MCL where there is a broken link to the parent Alternate Contact Folder.
- Recognizes option to skip creating contact items for DLs within Mandatory Contact Lists.
- Fixed bug that was logging incorrect date for start of scheduled EPS, BPE or SSU run.

- Added ability to use folder in private mailbox as Alternate Contact Source and Mandatory Contact List.
- Added UI to include/exclude DLs when pushing out Mandatory Contact Lists.
- Changed all forms with data about folder paths to display path as stepped hierarchy.

- Changed PINDL logic so that it will update on any EPS run; previously it was skipped if a user list was specified.

- Modified launch logic for scheduled tasks to add some flexibility, so that if two tasks are scheduled simultaneously the second task will remain queued for up to five minutes rather than being immediately skipped and rescheduled.

- Updated Restore procedure to recognize user override for MCL sub-folder and to skip contacts with no SMTP address.
- Fixed procedure that removes obsolete mandatory contacts so it works correctly if user override is set for MCL sub-folder
- Added logic to respect the Private flag on user contacts. When this option is in effect for a mailbox EPS will only update the PIN value on a Private contact and not touch other fields. A Private contact will be ignored during all Mandatory Contact operations, which means:
 - it will never be moved to the itrezzo MCL sub-folder
 - it will never be removed even if obsolete
 - if it matches a Mandatory Contact, even if it was originally created by EPS, on subsequent runs EPS will create and maintain a duplicate record.
- Modified the backup procedure to set the Private flag. This means that if a user manually restores a contact by dragging the attachment from the backup message to a folder that restored contact will be marked Private. Note that the “Respect Private flag” option must be in effect for that user’s mailbox in order for the Private flag to have any effect.
- Modified the automated restore procedure to *clear* the Private flag – contacts restored by this route will *not* be marked Private.
- Fixed bug in calculating LastChangeDate for Incremental update when new data was received for a previously empty field.
- Modified communication between agent and watchdog service to prevent inappropriate restarts by watchdog during long-running procedures.

- Fixed bugs in manual restore procedure
- Added UI to set the “Respect Private flag” option as a global EPS property, for a specific EPS run or as a user override on an individual mailbox.
- Modified the selective restore procedure to clear the Private flag, consistent with the way that agent does an automated restore.

Agent

- Recognizes new option to exclude data for recipients marked as hidden in AD
- When specific target mailboxes are selected for an EPS run the agent will now try to provision and license any new users automatically. If that process fails, for instance if there are no EPS seats available, then an email alert will be sent to the admin reporting the mailbox address and the reason for failure.
- Fixed bug that could fail to move all contacts to the main folder after the option to use the MCL subfolder was de-selected.

- Uses ping to check connectivity to Exchange server as first step during each MAPI session check *unless* it is using a profile to logon in which case it doesn't know what server to ping.
- If server uptime exceeds the specified minimum (reg DWORD "MinDaysRunning") and no task is scheduled during the next X minutes (reg DWORD "MinTaskWindow") the agent now writes a flag to let the watchdog know that it is willing to be restarted. The flag is re-evaluated during each timer interval and the flag is updated as soon as the value changes.
- The watchdog service initiates a "voluntary" restart by sending a specific control code. When it receives that command the agent clears the flag and then logs receipt of the code by writing "Responding to Control Code to prepare for restart". The watchdog will issue a Stop command ½ second later; once the agent has stopped it will send a Start command.

Admin

- Details dialog now shows user-defined properties (Outlook UserProperties) in bold if they exist.
- Servers container now loads all objects with grey icon first, then tries to determine service status for each agent. Admin attempts to query service status only if server responds to ping request.
- The process that periodically updates the task/status messages in the Servers container now also queries the service status (running, stopped, other) on each cycle – but any servers that didn't respond to the initial ping request are skipped.
- Changed two labels on configuration dialog for EPS Now, and fixed enable/disable code for radio buttons.

Watchdog

- The watchdog now also pings the Exchange server before attempting to logon, *unless* it is using a profile.
- The watchdog checks the "request restart" flag

- Changes to improve interaction with iAWatchdog service so it can handle situation where agent gets stuck in a partial shutdown.

To be valid a query must return one column named Email1 or a column named UniqueID. UniqueID is used only for an MCL based on the query that has the "Include no SMTP" flag set. Email1 will be used as the primary SMTP address unless it is actually a secondary proxy for an AD record – in that case Email1 will be changed to match the primary SMTP address found in AD.

A record will only be imported if it has a valid email address in the Email1 field, or a value for UniqueID. Records that don't satisfy these criteria will be ignored.
